1. Call to Order

a. Mr. Alton called the PAC meeting to order at 6:01 p.m.

2. Roll Call – Introduction

a. Mr. Alton took roll. Fourteen voting PAC members and three alternate members were present at the time of roll call and a quorum was established. Ms. Mouton arrived after roll call making a total of fifteen voting PAC members.

3. Adoption of Agenda

a. Ms. Kephart motioned to approve the agenda for September 19 and Ms. Kerswell seconded the motion. All members in favor, motion passed.

4. Approval of Minutes

a. Ms. Pacheco motioned to approve the minutes from May 23rd. Ms. Vasquez seconded the motion. All members in favor, motion passed.

5. Madera Minutes Video

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a. The PAC members viewed the Madera Minutes video highlighting events that took place throughout Madera Unified.

6. Introduction of New PAC Members for 2018-19 School Year

a. PAC members introduced themselves.

7. PAC Welcome Kit

a. 9. Review, Discuss and Consider Amendments to PAC Bylaws

a. The PAC members reviewed and discussed the PAC bylaws, and considered adding a part about decorum during committee meetings.

10. Opportunity for public input

- a. Among other topics, the PAC discussed:
 - i. Request made for the registration process to be completed online without having to also travel to the school site for a wet signature when electronic signatures are legal.
 - ii. The need for afterschool transportation for students in extra-curricular activities that go past the normal late bus hours for the high schools
 - iii. Afterschool program should also include Kindergarten students
 - iv. Concern regarding child nutrition and request for an update from the Director of Child Nutrition
 - v. Toilet paper should be replaced more often than it is now at MSHS
 - vi. The need for shade structures and good quality blacktop at Adams school
 - vii. Several PAC members voiced their concerns about the need to address decorum during the PAC meetings
 - viii. Concern regarding lock blocks at the high school and their effectiveness.

 The Superintendent addressed the concern and explained the purpose of the locks
 - ix. The representative from Rose Elementary expressed concern and discontent.
