


2. **Credits:** To be considered "On-Track" for graduation, students must meet the minimum credits for each grade level:

	<u>Grade</u>	<u>1st Semester</u> <u>(August)</u>	2nd Semester (January)

STANDING	12th	110	145

## 3. Grade Point Average (GPA)

- Student **must** maintain a minimum overall GPA of 2.0
- How to Calculate the grade point average (GPA). Add grade points and then dividing the total points by the number of grades





## How many credits can I earn and make-up at MVHS?

- Mountain Vista High runs on a 3-Week Term system to issue grades and credits for students.
- The Semester is broken up into 6 Terms
- Every 3 weeks, a student who is passing a course with a "D" or better grades earns "1" credit per class.
- Students are enrolled in 6 classes so they have the opportunity to earn "6" credits per class each Term for a Total of 36 Credits per semester.
- Students also have the opportunity to complete Standards Based Performance Tasks/Projects to earn an additional **1.5 Credits** per class.
- Overall, students have the opportunity to earn 45 Credits each Semester

## Are there any additional Credit Recovery Opportunities?

- After School Program: can earn up to 10 Elective Credits each semester
- 7th Period/After School: earn up to 5 credits
