It was a packed house. Thank you parents, teachers, staff, administrators and the community at large. The MUSD music program is flourishing. We could not have made the evening a success without your support.



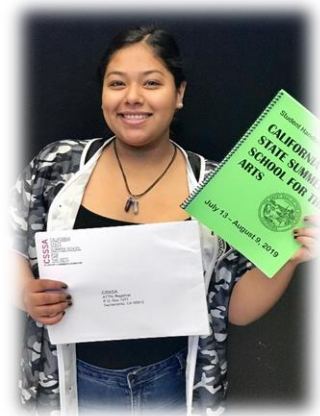
