- 6. New Business
  - a. Mrs. Ana Giron Parent Advisory Committee Update
    - i. April 10 (last PAC meeting). Helping kids to achieve greater education. Working to maximize student achievement. Hiring and retaining qualified educators. Parents are very thankful for the Me2Be reports. Rallies and PBIS programs have been encouraging students to do better. Feedback from parents are very important, parents often see things that the staff doesn't.
  - b. PBIS Update
    - -Positive culture, Students are being rewarded for being caught doing positive behavior -looking to recruit students and/or parents next year for committee

- -Student store- students are enjoying the store and looking forward to buying things from the store. (5 tickets = 1 Bear Buck)
- -Kids have to know why they earned the PAW ticket (being caught, not asking for ticket)
- -Data Drive (referrals) most are being seen in lower grades.
- -Store is happening during recess
- -Award Application: Changes have been made, expectations have increased in order to qualify for higher awards. Possibly awarded Silver award this year.
- c. ELPAC Testing Update
  - -658 students in school, 285 EL students, (61 given Initial ELPAC)
  - -all completed except 3 students (will be completed this week)
  - -scores should be returned by end of year
- d. CA English Learner Roadmap
  - -Hired consulting firm to help to apply principle 1 and 2 in the classroom.
  - -Teachers asked to reflect on principles/indicators and if they are included in their classrooms
  - -Principle 2 is the focus this year (focus on instruction), more student led versus teacher led.
  - -designated ELD (45 minutes), focused on ELD Standards when developing lessons
  - -staff looked at indicators then looked at 4th grade video lesson. (Students were the leaders because it was frontloaded during the ELD lesson)
  - -strategies are great for ALL students but specifically EL students
  - -EL Students need more support and strategies to grasp the material, students begin to start making connections and feel respected.
- e. NWEA Update
  - -Adaptive test, given 3 times
  - -60th percentile
  - -MSUD goal is 80% of students meet their Best Growth Target in 2024/25
  - -Tested in Reading and Math
  - -Achievement- students who are at or higher than grade level
  - -close correlation with CAASPP and NWEA
- f. Field Trips
  - -Break Out Sessions
  - -Discuss and brainstorm possible field trips and fundraisers for next school year
