- Current SAP Initiatives

Theory of Action

- -K-2nd Focus on Phonics: sound out words, not rely on pictures or memorization. We want the students to depend on themselves, not rely on the help of adults.
- -Established Monroe Literacy Coalition, coaching cycles, grade level team work, data analysis, doing more center work in the classroom with the help of Ms. Larivee. K: 65% at or above grade level in phonics and word recognition, 1st-2nd are doing much better than previous years in Oral reading.
- -3-6th Focus on Writing: ELA/Genre Writing
- -Decisions are based on genres covered on CAASPP, rubrics were built, mentor texts are being used. Teaching students to write to the prompt. The plan is to first introduce the genres and have them become familiar with each genre. Then students are to write 2 pieces for each genre throughout the year.
- -Growth: 47.89 % of 3rd-6th met their best growth target from fall to spring in the area of reading
- -Achievement: 21.1% were in the met/exceeded category for spring NWEA reading
- -In the area of Math we plan to Change from a 3-read protocol to a number sense focus
- -All grade levels were positive in growth in the area of math.
- -Schoolwide growth: 47.89% in the area of math
- -Achievement 16% in the fall to 28% in the spring in the area of math
