Madera High School Drama students have begun rehearsal for their spring production, Clue, by Jonathan Lynn. Students are introduced to a new Drama vocabulary word: Stichomythia, meaning a technique in verse drama in which sequences of single alternating lines, or half-lines or two-line speeches are given to alternating characters. It typically features repetition and antithesis. The term originated in the theatre of Ancient Greece, though many dramatists since have used the technique.
